

Academy site to be converted

(Democrat and Chronicle, April 13, 2007) – The historic **Academy Building** on Fitzhugh Street in downtown Rochester has been acquired by Florida real estate developer George Traikos, who plans to convert the 134-year old structure into a mixed-use building.

Traikos said he intends to include offices, retail, residences and a restaurant in the building, which served as Rochester's first high school and later was used for Board of Education offices.
